Cannolis



Ingredients

Shell

- 4 cups of sifted all-purpose flour
- 2 Tablespoons sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 3 Tablespoons butter, softened
- 2 egg yolks
- 3/4 cup white wine
- Shortening for frying

Filling

- 4 cups whole milk ricotta cheese
- 1 1/2 cups powdered sugar
- 1 Tablespoon of vanilla
- 1/3 cup finely chopped maraschino cherries
- 1/4 cup cup semisweet mini chocolate chips
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream (optional)

Directions

1. To make shells, mix flour, sugar and salt in a bowl.
2. Cut in butter. Add egg yolks; stir with a fork.
3. Stir in wine, 1 tablespoon at a time, with a fork until dough clings together.
4. Form a ball with the dough and let stand for 30 minutes.
5. Roll dough almost paper thin, on a well-floured surface.
6. Using the rim of a margarita glass (about 3-4 inches across), make circle cutouts into rolled dough.
7. Roll each circle of dough around a metal cannoli tube, overlapping the ends and press to seal, flaring out the edges slightly.
8. Fry one or two at a time in hot melted shortening (about 360°F) for approximately 1 minute, turning to brown all sides.
9. Remove from hot grease and drain on paper towels, seam side down.
10. Let cool a minute or two before trying to remove metal tube.
11. Leave cannoli shells on paper towel, seam side down to cool completely.
12. For filling, drain ricotta cheese over cheesecloth if ricotta is watery.
13. Combine ricotta cheese, powdered sugar, and vanilla extract.
14. Squeeze Maraschino cherries with paper towels to remove all liquid.
15. Stir in cherries and chocolate chips into the ricotta mixture, being careful not to over mix.
16. For a lighter filling, you may whip 1 cup of heavy whipping cream to form stiff peaks, and fold into filling mixture at this step.
17. Chill filling for about 30 minutes before piping into cooled cannoli shells.
18. You may garnish the cannoli by sprinkling powdered sugar on top.
19. Keep refrigerated until time of serving.

WHAT IS A CANNOLI?

Cannolis are from the Sicily region of Italy. Cannoli consist of tube-shaped shells of fried pastry dough, filled with a sweet, creamy filling usually containing ricotta cheese. American versions often replace the ricotta with custards or creams. While sticking with the traditional ricotta filling might sound weird, it gives the cannoli a much more complex, satisfying flavor.

LOCAL LODI FACTS: LODI & A.V.A.

Lodi became part of the American Viticulture Area– AVA– in 1986. An AVA is a designated wine grape growing region recognized by the federal government. According to the Lodi Wine commission, "Lodi is America's most widely planted AVA, with currently over 113,000 acres of wine grapes in the ground. In comparison to Lodi's 113,000 acres, there are approximately 43,000 acres planted in Napa Valley, and just over 60,000 acres in all of Sonoma County. Table grapes and raisins – major crops in the southern half of the Central Valley – are not cultivated in Lodi. It's all about vino here in the Delta."

So now when you see all those vineyards around town, you can be certain almost all of those grapes will grow up to be part of a lovely bottle of wine. Cheers!

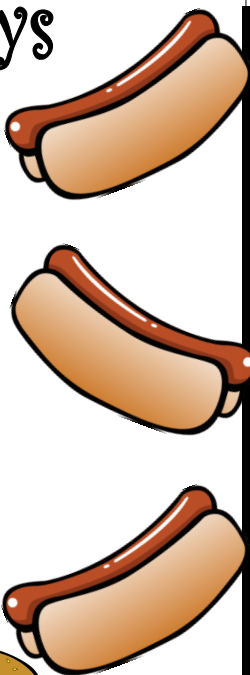
